Grade 7 Bible Verses

Lesson	Text	Verse
1	Revelation 1:8	“ ‘I am the Alpha and the Omega - the beginning and the end.,’ says the Lord God. ‘I am the one who is, who always was, and who is still to come, the Almighty One’ ”
2	Ezekiel 28:12-15	“Son of man, sing this funeral song for the king of Tyre. Give him this message from the Sovereign Lord: You were the model of perfection, full of wisdom and exquisite in beauty . . . You were blameless in all you did from the day you were created until the day evil was found in you”
3	Revelation 12:7, 8	“Then there was war in heaven. Michael and his angels fought against the dragon and his angels. And the dragon lost the battle, and he and his angels were forced out of heaven”
4	Genesis 1:26, 27	“Then God said, ‘Let us make human beings in our image, to be like ourselves. They will reign over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, the livestock, all the wild animals on the earth, and the small animals that scurry along the ground.’ ” “So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them”
5	Isaiah 59:1, 2	“Listen! The Lord’s arm is not too weak to save you, nor is his ear too deaf to hear you call. It’s your sins that have cut you off from God. Because of your sins, he has turned away and will not listen anymore”
6	1 John 4:9, 10	“God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. This is real love - not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins”
7	Genesis 6:5, 6	“The Lord observed the extent of human wickedness on the earth, and he saw that everything they thought or imagined was consistently and totally evil. So the Lord was sorry he had ever made them and put them on the earth. It broke his heart”
8	Psalm 46:1-3	“God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble. So we will not fear when earthquakes come and the mountains crumble into the sea. Let the oceans roar and foam. Let the mountains tremble as the waters surge!”
9	Hebrews 11:17, 18	“It was by faith that Abraham offered Isaac as a sacrifice when God was testing him. Abraham, who had received God’s promises, was ready to sacrifice his only son, Isaac, even though God had told him, ‘Isaac is the son through whom your descendants will be counted’ ”

10	1 John 1:8, 9	“If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness”
11	Matthew 22:37-40	“ ‘Jesus replied, “You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all our soul, and all your mind.” This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: “Love your neighbor as yourself.” The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments’ ”
12	Exodus 25:8	“Have the people of Israel to build me a holy sanctuary so I can live among them”
13	<i>My Life Today</i> , page 161	“Those who in everything make God first and last and best are the happiest people in the world”
14	1 Kings 18:21	“Elijah stood in front of them and said, ‘How much longer will you waver, hobbling between two opinions? If the Lord is God, follow him! But if Baal is God, then follow him!’ But the people were completely silent”
15	Daniel 2:20-22	“Praise the name of God forever and ever; for he has all wisdom and power. He controls the course of world events; he removes kings and sets up other kings . . . He reveals deep and mysterious things and knows what lies hidden in darkness, though he is surrounded by light”
16	Isaiah 43:2	“When you go through deep waters, I will be with you. When you go through rivers of difficulty, you will not drown. When you walk through the fire of oppression, you will not be burned up; the flames will not consume you”
17	Matthew 2:10, 11	“When they saw the star, they were filled with joy! They entered the house and saw the child with his mother, Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasure chests and gave him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh”
18	1 Corinthians 10:13	“The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure”
19	Romans 8:2	“The power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death”
20	Matthew 26:39	“He went on a little farther and bowed with his face to the ground, praying, ‘My Father! If it is possible, let this cup of suffering be taken away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine’ ”
21	John 17:25, 26	“O righteous Father, the world doesn’t know you, but I do; and these disciples know you sent me. I have revealed you to them, and I will continue to do so. Then your love for me will be in them, and I will be in them”

22	Zechariah 4:6	“Then he said to me, ‘This is what the Lord says to Zerubbabel: It is not by force nor by strength, but by my Spirit, says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies’ ”
23	John 16:33	“I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world”
24	2 Timothy 3:16	“All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right”
25	John 1:5	“The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it”
26	Romans 1:17	“This Good News tells us how God makes us right in his sight. This is accomplished from start to finish by faith. As the Scriptures say, ‘It is through faith that a righteous person has life’ ”
27	Mark 13:28, 29	“Now learn a lesson from the fig tree. When its branches bud and its leaves begin to sprout, you know that summer is near. In the same way, when you see all these things taking place, you can know that his return is very near, right at the door”
28	1 Thessalonians 4:16-18	“The Lord himself will come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet call of God. First, the Christians who have died will rise from their graves. Then, together with them, we who are still alive and remain on the earth will be caught up in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. Then we will be with the Lord forever. So encourage each other with these words”
29	Amos 3:7	“Indeed, the Sovereign Lord never does anything until he reveals his plans to his servants the prophets”
30	Jeremiah 1:5-8	“ ‘I knew you before I formed you in your mother’s womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations.’ “ ‘O Sovereign Lord,’ I said, ‘I can’t speak for you! I’m too young!’ “The Lord replied, ‘Don’t say, “I’m too young,” for you must go wherever I send you and say whatever I tell you. And don’t be afraid of the people, for I will be with you and will protect you. I, the Lord, have spoken!’ ”
31	Matthew 24:24, 25	“False messiahs and false prophets will rise up and perform great signs and wonders so as to deceive, if possible, even God’s chosen ones. See, I have warned you about this ahead of time”
32	Isaiah 25:9, 10	“In that day the people will proclaim, ‘This is our God! We trusted in him, and he saved us! This is the Lord, in whom we trusted. Let us rejoice in the salvation he brings!’ For the Lord’s hand of blessing will rest on Jerusalem”

33	John 5:28, 29	“Don’t be so surprised! Indeed, the time is coming when all the dead in their graves will hear the voice of God’s Son, and they will rise again. Those who have done good will rise to experience eternal life, and those who have continued in evil will rise to experience judgment”
34	Revelation 21:4	“He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever”
35	Revelation 21:1-3	“Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the old heaven and the old earth had disappeared. And the sea was also gone . . . I heard a loud shout from the throne, saying, ‘Look, God’s home is now among his people! He will live with them, and they will be his people. God himself will be with them’ ”
